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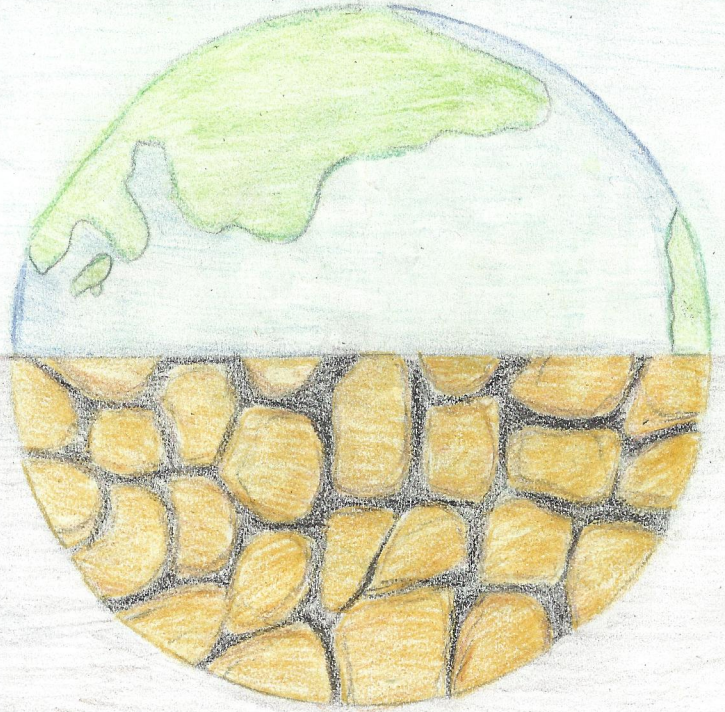

You want to spend time with your friends and also rent a kayak for free while you're saving the nature? Then go for a trip on a Greenkayak!

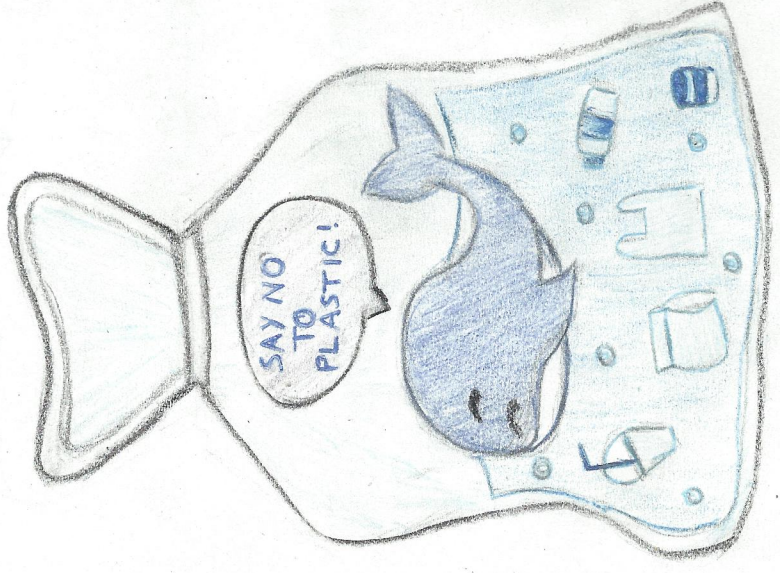

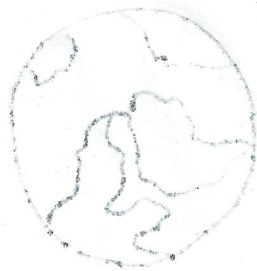
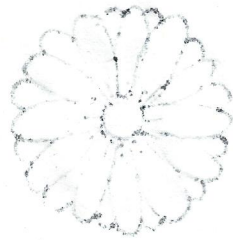

How can you help?

You get a canoe for free but just for 2 hours. The canoe is easy to steer and for 2 people. And you also get an info flyer with tips where you can find garbage and which areas may not to be entered. Also there is a garbage collection commitment around the Alster. About ten tons of garbage were collected through the voluntary commitment of hundreds of people.



Where is it

There are a lot of places where you can borrow canoes like: on the Alster 47, to the Gondel, Kaemmererufer 25, SUP CLUB Hamburg, Isekai 1

What happens there?

As we said you get a canoe for free and for 2 hours. Then you weigh your garbage in kilo and tons. This experience is posted on the internet and with the #greenkayak. The #greenkayak is used for the people who don't speak german. And the #sauberesachefürhamburg is used for the people who speak german. This experiment will go for 3 years.

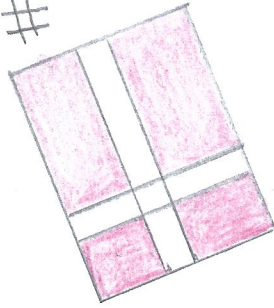

Green Kaugh in Denmark

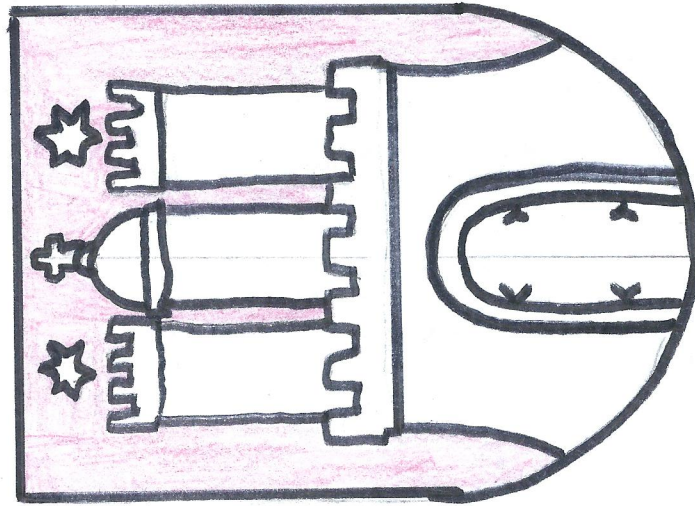
Green Kaugh is an environmental initiative that aims to free coastal regions, harbours and rivers from plastic pollution. Since 2017, the Danes in Copenhagen and Hamburg have been offering volunteers to foodlers to visit Kaugh for free. If they collect garbage from under and share it with hashings (#greenkaugh) on social media. The Danes have so far collected ten tons of garbage and Hamburg is now the first foreign partner.

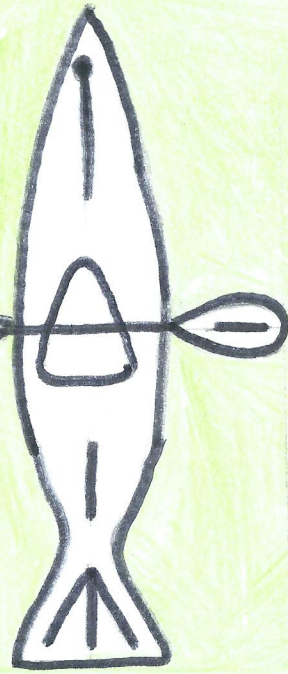

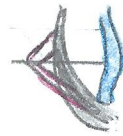
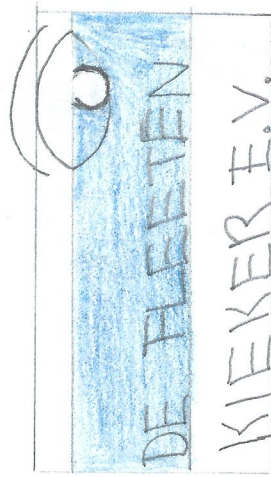


Keeping the Alster cleaner

There are other possibilities for waste collection commitment around the Alster: The club Fleeteriker E.V. at the Krammstr. organizes rides with two boats on the Alster and the adjacent channels and flows with the aim to collect garbage. In January, the association UYA (clean up your Alster) has also made a trash collection in front of the water or on the water with stand-up-paddling boards. In addition, the Alster waters on behalf of the Environmental Agency are also cleaned all years round roads, bikes & waters German: Landesbetrieb Straßen, Brücken & Gewässer = LSBG

Abtesting is automatically for two persons! One person must be at least 18 years old and all volunteers need to be able to swim. If you have a disability you can still participate in the project.

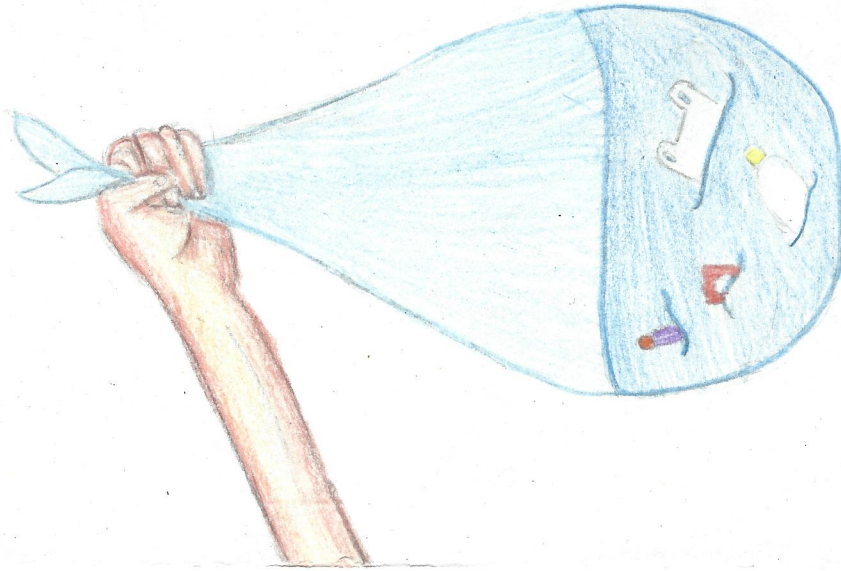
Aims for Hamburg

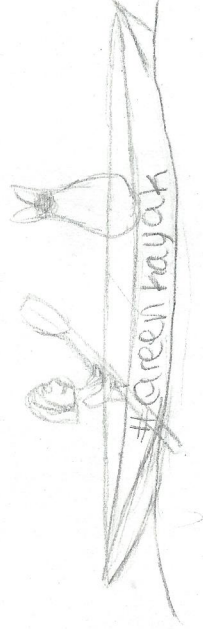
